Introductory remarks: Hygiene regulations in view of the COVID 19 pandemic

For the project meeting in Potsdam we are bound by the current regulations of the Federal Republic of Germany and the State of Brandenburg regarding the Corona Pandemic.

That means among other things:

In **public transport** (bus, train, tram) it is **mandatory** to wear a **mouth and nose cover**.

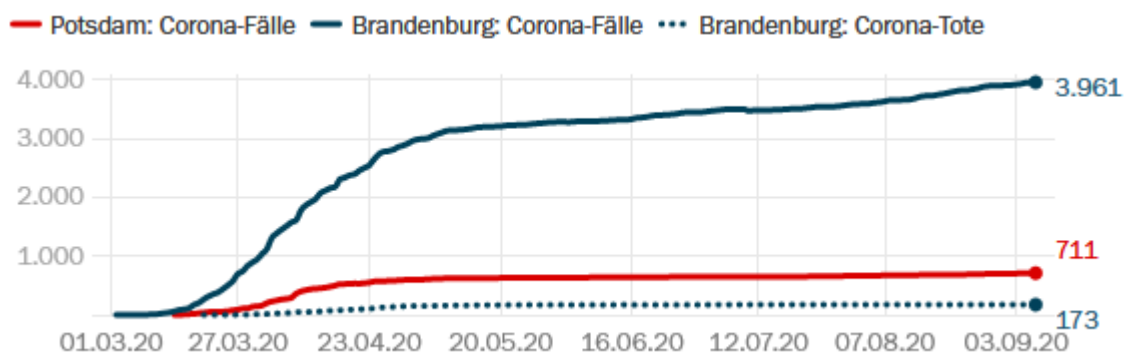
Events up to a maximum of 1,000 persons are generally permitted. For outdoor events, the general rules of distance and hygiene must be observed and the access and stay of participants must be controlled and restricted. For events in closed rooms, due to the comparatively higher risk of infection, organizers must also ensure that the room air is regularly replaced by fresh air and that personal data is recorded in an **attendance list** for the purpose of contact tracing. Participants do not have to wear a mouth and nose cover at meetings and events, but it is generally recommended.

The general rules of distance and hygiene are regarded as a central element of infection protection. Thus, every person is requested to observe the general rules of hygiene and hygiene recommendations to prevent infections. These include especially regular and thorough washing of hands, coughing and sneezing, preferably in a disposable handkerchief or in the crook of the arm, avoiding physical contact such as shaking hands and hugs when greeting or saying goodbye, regular airing of all recreation rooms.

Keeping your distance is one of the most important behavioural measures for protection against the corona virus. For this reason, a **minimum distance of 1.5 meters** must continue to be maintained between persons in public and private areas.

This minimum distance also applies during our project meeting: If this distance cannot be maintained, we urgently request that you wear a mouth-nose cover. Please do not move the tables and chairs in the event hall!

The figures in Potsdam / in the state of Brandenburg are shown in the following table (Sept, 7th, 2020):



In the city of Potsdam there are officially cumulated 711 "Corona cases". Of these, however, 628 people are already considered to have recovered.

We assume that participants who show symptoms of Covid 19 disease would not participate in our project meeting, and therefore an infection among each other is very unlikely (although unfortunately not impossible).

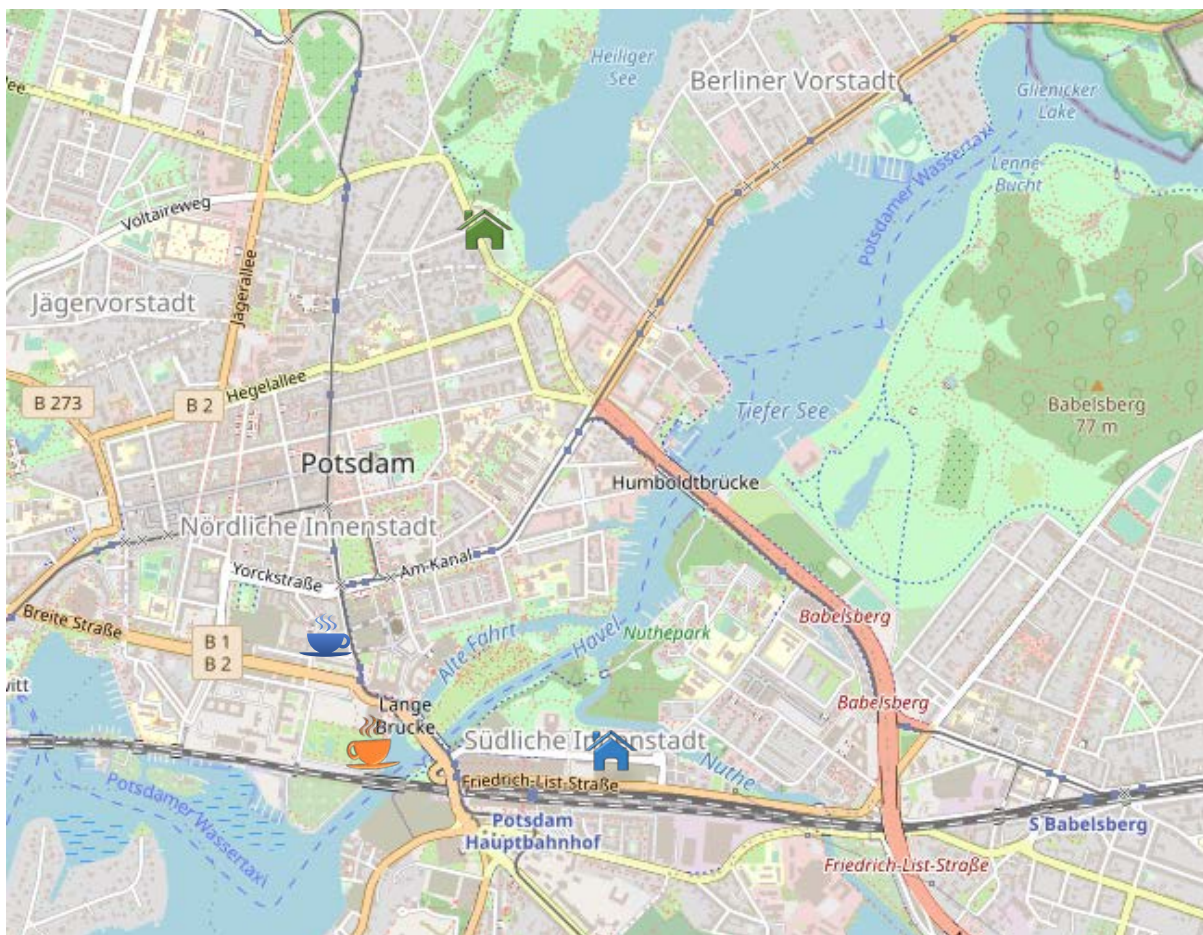


GENERAL INFORMATION

Potsdam is the capital and largest city of the German federal state of Brandenburg and has about 178.000 inhabitants. In the south-west of Berlin, Potsdam lay just outside West Berlin after the construction of the Berlin Wall.

An 'island' completely surrounded by water, Potsdam's riverside became the designated route of part of the Berlin Wall, stretching over a length of 160 kilometres. The famous Glienicke Bridge became a key sector border between West Berlin and the GDR/East Germany, well known for its exchange of agents, military and diplomats belonging to both political systems.

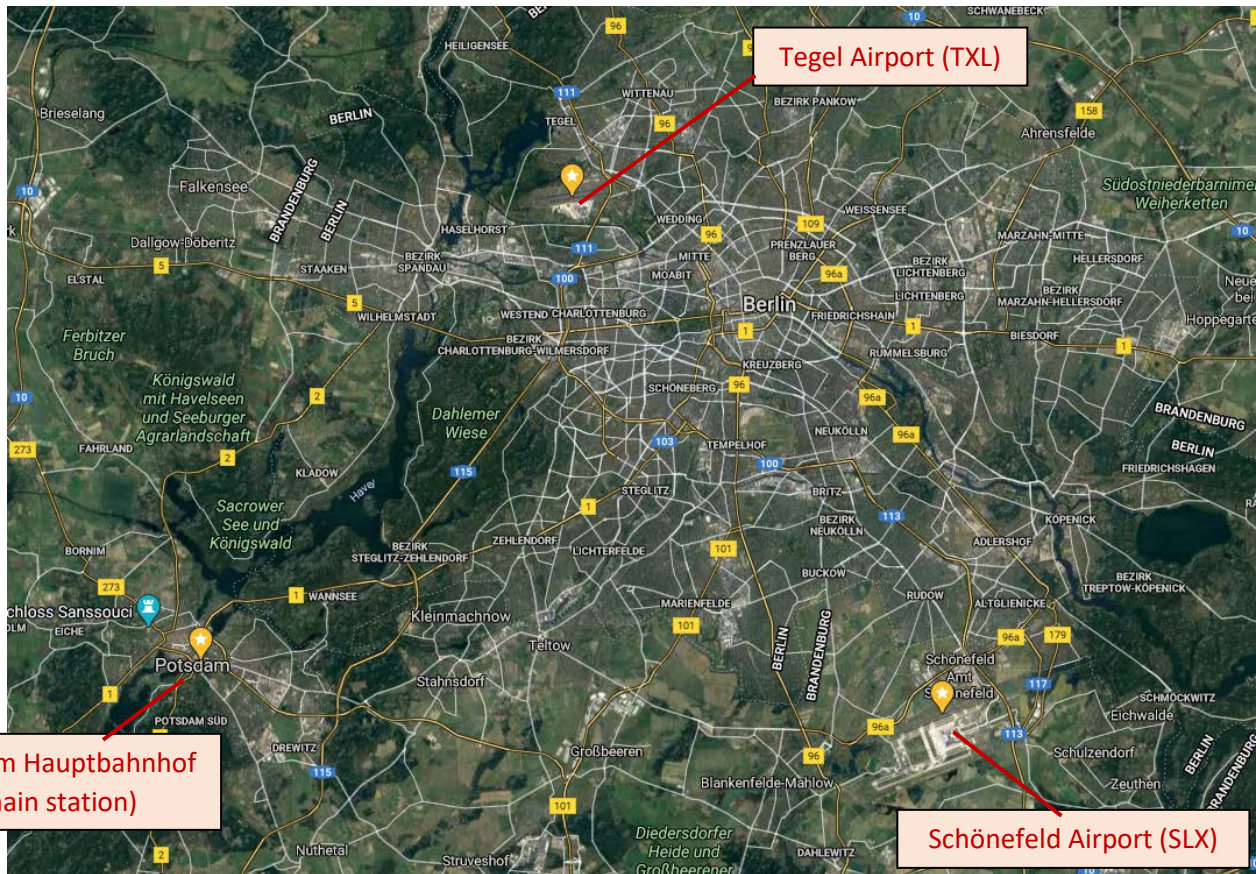

From Tegel airport (TXL) to Potsdam, B & B Hotel

- Please take a bus when you leave of the airport building
- You can choose **Bus TXL** or **Bus 109** (direction S+U Zoologischer Garten)



- Check times and itineraries on the following link for public transportation:

- **Bus 109** (direction S+U Zoologischer Garten) – get out at **Gervinusstraße** (11 stops), where you can change to S-Bahn train (**S Charlottenburg** station) – choose train S7 (direction Potsdam Hbf; 7 stops) or regional train RE1 (direction Magdeburg/Brandenburg; 2 stops) – get out at **Potsdam Hauptbahnhof** (0'50 TXL – Potsdam)
- **Bus TXL** (direction S+U Hauptbahnhof) – get out at **Berlin Main Station (Hauptbahnhof)** – choose train S7 (direction Potsdam Hbf; 12 stops) or regional train RE1 (direction Magdeburg/Brandenburg; 4 stops) – get out at **Potsdam Hauptbahnhof**

At Potsdam Hauptbahnhof: choose the exit “Potsdamer Straße” – turn right – it is just 100m to the B&B Hotel!

Tickets: You can buy tickets inside the airport building or at the ticket machines beside the bus stop. Going from Berlin to Potsdam please choose “**Single ticket Berlin ABC**” (3,60 €).

From Schönefeld airport (SXF) to Potsdam, Altstadt hotel

- Leaving the airport building, follow the signs to the public trains and take the path through a kind of gallery

- **RB 22:** The only direct train from Schönefeld to Potsdam Hauptbahnhof, going once per hour (leaving 20 minutes past the full hour). (0'51 SFX – Potsdam)
- **any train that goes to the centre of Berlin (Ostbahnhof, Hauptbahnhof,..)** – choose train S7 (direction Potsdam Hbf; 7 stops) or regional train RE1 (direction Magdeburg/Brandenburg; 2 stops) – get out at **Potsdam Hauptbahnhof** (approx. 1'10 SFX – Potsdam)

At Potsdam Hauptbahnhof: choose the exit “Potsdamer Straße” – turn right – it is just 100m to the B&B Hotel!

Tickets: You can buy tickets at the ticket machines inside the “tunnel” to the train station. Going from Berlin to Potsdam please choose “**Single ticket Berlin ABC**” (3,60 €).
